## Minimum Education Level, Certification, and Experience

- A. Associates Degree in Audio Visual or Related Field
- B. Graduation from High School and One year of full-time experience in audio-visual work involving the operation and minor maintenance of a variety of audio-visual equipment; or
- C. Any equivalent combination of experience training

## Job Goal:

Audio Visual (AV) technicians set up and run the sound and video equipment for live events such as meetings, sports games, business conventions, and concerts. They mix soundboards, play video recordings, enhance lighting, and coordinate graphics. AV technicians must be able to work days, nights, and weekends because they support events during these times. They also assist in the streaming of events via web services such as YouTube, Google Meets, Cisco WebX, and Zoom.
