Prioritize Attendance: Every day counts! Being in the classroom consistently ensures your leader doesn't miss out on collaborative projects and key foundational lessons.


Celebrate Small Wins: Growth isn't just about grades. Praise your child when you see them show kindness, solve a problem peacefully, or try again after a mistake.


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


