Spring Dance Concert

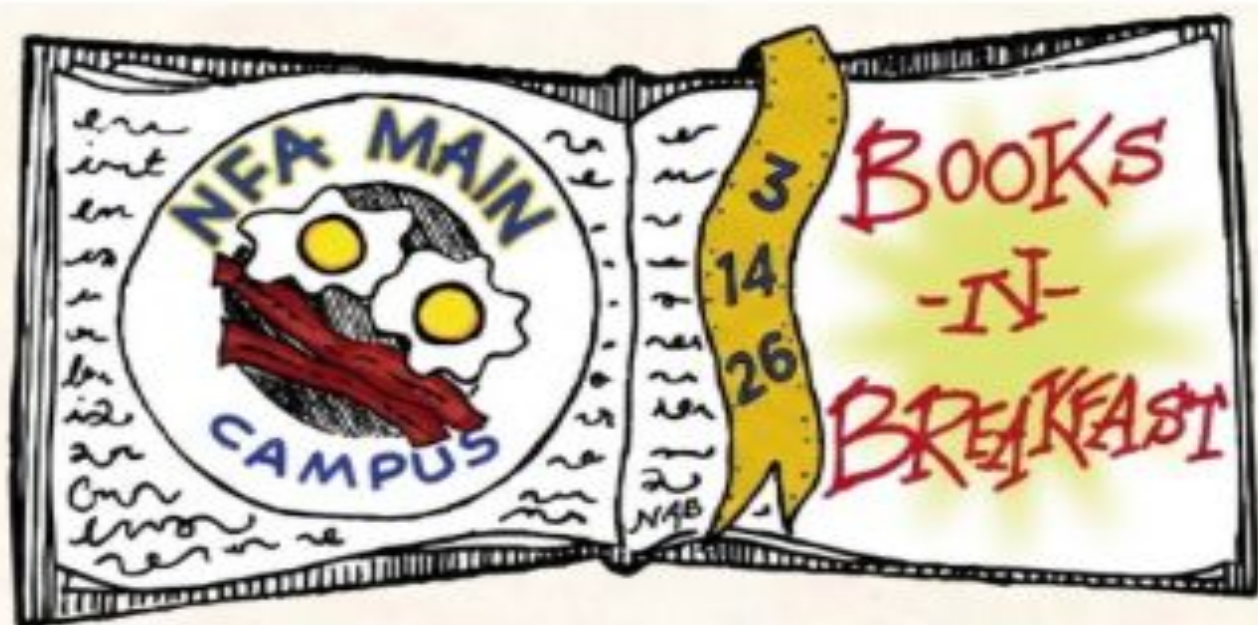
