### Dates and Deadlines for November's General Election

**Oct. 9, 2020:** Last day to postmark voter registration or register in person at the Orange County Board of Elections

**Oct. 27, 2020:** Last date to postmark application for absentee ballot

**Nov. 2, 2020:** Last day to apply in person for absentee ballot

**Nov. 3, 2020:** Election Day. Polls open 6 AM to 9 PM. You will receive a postcard with your poll site address.

Also, last date to deliver your absentee ballot in person to the Board of Elections

Also, last day to postmark your Absentee Ballot for the General Election



# Before You Vote

## Can I Vote?

You can vote if: \*

- You are a U.S. citizen
- You are 18 years old by the date of the election
- You live at your present address for at least 30 days before the election

\*For those on parole for a felony, find out about Voting Restoration Pardons at [www.ny.gov/services/apply-clemency](http://www.ny.gov/services/apply-clemency)

# Three Ways to Vote—Your Choice

## 1. Vote Early, In Person

**From October 24 - November 1,** Orange County voters can vote at any of these sites:

- City of Newburgh Activity Center, 401 Washington St, **Newburgh**
- Cornwall Ambulance Building, 1 Clinton St, **Cornwall**
- Warwick Town Hall, 132 Kings Highway, **Warwick**
- Middletown Senior Center, 62-70 West Main St, **Middletown**
- Montgomery Senior Center, 36 Bridge St, **Montgomery**
- Delaware Engine Company #2, 22 Hammond St, **Port Jervis**
- Monroe Town Hall, 1465 Orange Turnpike, **Monroe**

### Early Voting Hours:

- Saturday October 24 from Noon to 5 PM
- Sunday October 25 from 10 AM to 3 PM
- Monday October 26 from Noon to 8 PM
- Tuesday October 27 from 7 AM to 3 PM
- Wednesday October 28 from Noon to 8 PM
- Thursday October 29 from 7 AM to 3 PM
- Friday October 30 from Noon to 8 PM
- Saturday October 31 from 10 AM to 3 PM

## 2. Vote on Election Day, Tuesday, Nov. 3

**Vote** at your local polling place. Watch for a postcard with your poll site location.

## 3. Vote Absentee

Anyone can vote absentee in 2020 by using the “temporary illness” option.

- Apply for an absentee ballot at NY's online portal: [absentee-ballot.elections.ny.gov](http://absentee-ballot.elections.ny.gov). Deliver the ballot in person if you can.
